Re: European Union Reportable Materials Directives

To Whom It May Concern:

As a distributor, AIN Plastics states that we do not use any of the elements listed in The Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive (RoHS) and The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive (WEEE) in the processing/handling of material.

As a distributor, AIN Plastics is working with all of the producing manufacturers from whom we receive our products to ascertain the amounts of RoHS elements, if any, that are used in their material production processes. Those replies will be made available to our customers for the materials they purchased.

Because we are reliant on the information supplied by these manufactures and that we do not have the means to test for all the substances referenced in the RoHS Directive, AIN Plastics is unable to provide any type of written statement concerning compliance to the directive *prior to our possession of material.*

Thank you for your understanding in this matter and I hope this clears up any confusion regarding this subject.
